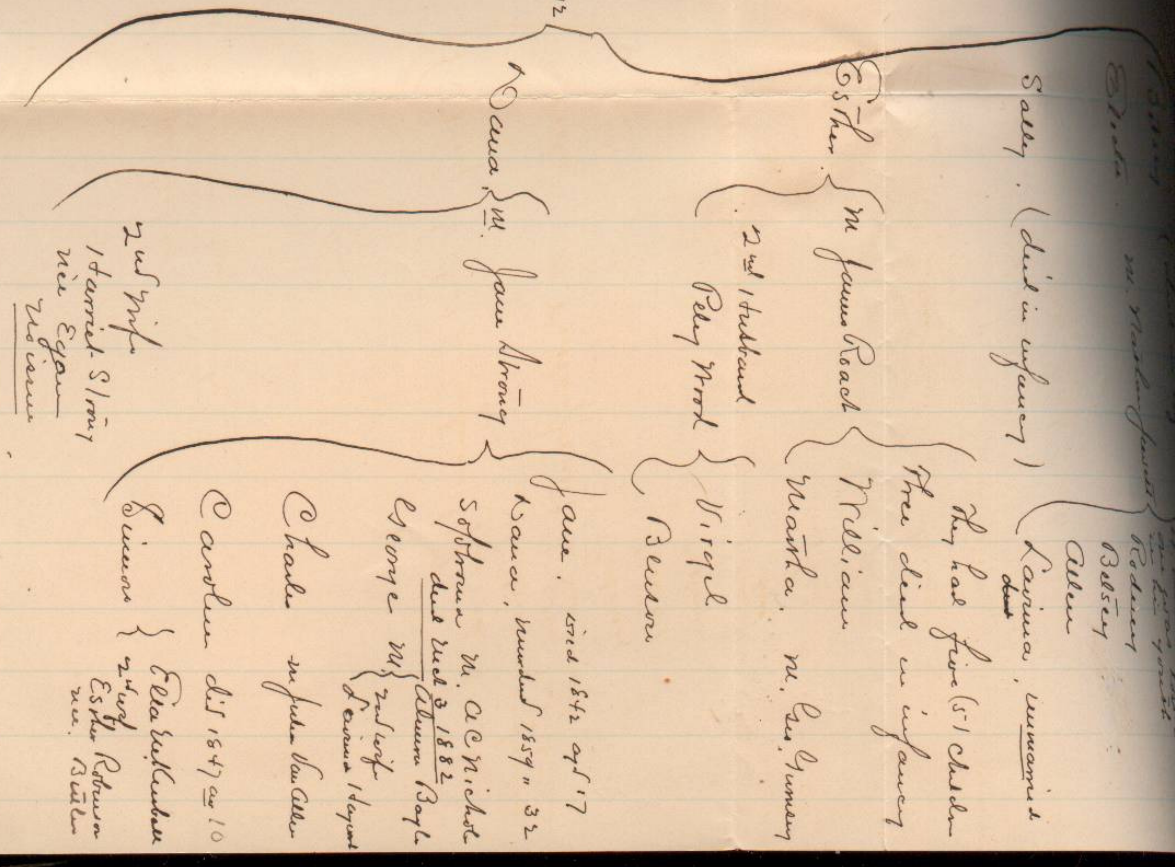

Jane was of a sweet and amiable temper, whose prospect of a long and cheerful life might have rendered this abrupt approach of death startling and trying in the extreme. But, 'through the tender mercy of our God,' who 'delighteth not in the death of the sinner,' a timely preparation was given her for this solemn event. During a recent protracted meeting held in Lansing, God gave her 'repentance unto life' and took her sins away, depriving death of his 'sting,' so that this timid youth came to this unexpected conflict without fear or the slightest misgivings, and triumphed gloriously. How striking is God's grace magnified in the 'death of his saints.' What but his grace can render *cheerful* that mournful event? What but this can afford *light* in that 'hour and power of darkness'? What but this could keep *calm* the soul of a timid child in this frightful strife and make her a solacing angel to break the silence of this speechless moment with words of comfort and shouts of triumph. It is this that flushes the cheek of paleness, that brightens the eye of dimness and that wreaths the brow of sadness with a halo of glorious light in the dying hour. How soothing and supporting to bereaved pious parents, in their mourning, that they 'sorrow not even as others that have no hope.' 'It is well with the child,' and 'it shall be well with the righteous' world without end.

In Highland, Doniphan Co., Kansas, Aug. 12, JANE, wife of Rev. Dana Fox, aged 61 years and 11 days.

For more than forty years Sister Fox had been a devoted christian and faithful member of the M. E. Church, having been happily converted to God in early youth.

Brother and Sister Fox bid farewell to their friends in Elmira, New York, in April last, and removed to this place, with the design of making Highland the pilgrims rest this side of Jordan for the remnant of their days. They had fitted up a pleasant and convenient cottage in the beautiful little village of Highland, and were busily engaged in beautifying and ornamenting it, that they might have a pleasant home in which to close up their mortal career. Sister Fox seemed contented and happy. Two of her sons were settled here, and she looked forward with pleasing anticipation to the time when her only daughter would settle near her, and her youngest son finish his course in the Genesee College and make Kansas his home. Our Sister was not permitted to realize these anticipations; she was suddenly and unexpectedly called from these mortal shores—but when death came it found her ready. She had a mansion fitted up in Heaven; she had a richer treasure there, and she could well afford to exchange her cottage in the wilderness for a mansion in the skies. Sister Fox was a faithful wife, an affectionate mother, a kind neighbor, and a devoted christian. A few hours before she took her final leave of earth, her husband asked her if "all is well?" She answered "Yes." "Are you willing to die?" She answered with a distinct whisper, "Yes." With the most perfect resignation she committed her blood-washed spirit into the hands of her Redeemer and Saviour, and without a struggle or groan she sweetly fell asleep in Jesus.
