

Ancestors of LaMar Dyches Gulbransen (9)

Generation One

1. LaMar Dyches¹ Gulbransen (9) (*Charles Dyches*, #2) was born on 10 March 1925 at Wales, Sanpete County, Utah.¹ He married as his first wife Mary Ann Green (10), daughter of Willis Wilson Green (1119) and Ida Blanche Gardner (1120), on 27 August 1947 at Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah.² He and Mary Ann Green (10) were divorced circa 1960.³ He married as his second wife Jeanne Hull (1108), daughter of Frank Gilbert Hull (4193) and Winifred Gertrude Tuttle (4194), circa 1965.¹ He died on 18 September 2002 at Sutter Coast Hospital, Crescent City, Del Norte County, California, at age 77.⁴

He was adopted by his mother's sister Anna Pauline Nielsen (1124) and her husband Frederick Gulbransen (1118) in 1925 after the death of his mother a month after his birth.¹

Generation Two

2. Charles Thomas² Dyches (1115) (*Thomas*, #4) was born on 30 April 1883 at Wales, Utah Territory.⁵ He married as his first wife Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116), daughter of Niels Peter Nielsen (1484) and Marian Poulsen (13461), on 31 May 1905 at Manti, Sanpete County, Utah.⁶ He married as his second wife Macel Beal (1117) on 22 December 1927 at Manti, Sanpete County, Utah.⁷ He died on 17 December 1964 at Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, at age 81.⁸ He was buried in Wales Cemetery, Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, Section 4.⁹

He appeared on the 1900 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of his parents Thomas William Dyches (1485) and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486).¹⁰ He and Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116) appeared on the 1910 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 19 April 1910. Their children William (9029), Charles Valdin (9030) and Jennie Elvira (9031) were listed as living with them.¹¹ He registered for the draft for World War I on 12 September 1918, while living at Manti, Sanpete County, Utah, reporting he was employed as farmer.¹² He and Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116) appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 7 January 1920. Their children William (9029), Charles Valdin (9030), Jennie Elvira (9031), Floyd (9032), Doyle Neilsen (9033) and Verda (9034) were listed as living with them.¹³ He and Macel Beal (1117) appeared on the 1930 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 10 April 1930. His children Floyd (9032), Doyle Neilsen (9033) and Verda (9034) were listed as living with them. Her children Ariala Howard (13928) and Arden Howard (13929) were also in the household.¹⁴

Children of Charles Thomas² Dyches (1115) and Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116) (see #3) were as follows:

- i. William¹ (9029) was born on 14 November 1905.¹⁵ He died in November 1982 at Utah. His last residence was Salt Lake City.¹⁶
- ii. Charles Valdin (9030) was born on 15 December 1907.¹⁵ He died in May 1969 at Utah at age 61. His last residence was Clawson, Emery County, UT.¹⁶
- iii. Jennie Elvira (9031) is still living.
- iv. Floyd (9032) was born on 22 November 1911.¹⁵ He died in August 1982 at Utah at age 70. His last residence was Salt Lake City.¹⁶
- v. Doyle Neilsen (9033) was born on 17 November 1913.¹⁵ He died on 23 June 1967 at Utah at age 53. His last residence was Mount Pleasant, Sanpete County, UT.¹⁷ He was buried in Mount Pleasant City Cemetery, Mount Pleasant, Sanpete County, Utah.¹⁸
- vi. Verda (9034); First name hard to read is still living.

3. Jennie Elvira² Nielsen (1116) (*Niels*, #6) was born on 13 December 1886 at Arhus, Arhus, Denmark.¹⁹ She married Charles Thomas Dyches (1115), son of Thomas William Dyches (1485) and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486), on 31 May 1905 at Manti, Sanpete County, Utah.⁶ She died on 16 April 1925 at Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, at age 38. Her cause of death was Chronic Parenchymatous Nephritis.²⁰ She was buried on 19 April 1925 in Wales Cemetery, Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, Section 4.²¹

She immigrated, arriving 1892 with her parents Niels Peter Nielsen (1484) and Marian Poulsen (13461).²² She and Charles Thomas Dyches (1115) appeared on the 1910 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 19

April 1910. Their children William (9029), Charles Valdin (9030) and Jennie Elvira (9031) were listed as living with them.¹¹ She and Charles Thomas Dyches (1115) appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 7 January 1920. Their children William (9029), Charles Valdin (9030), Jennie Elvira (9031), Floyd (9032), Doyle Neilsen (9033) and Verda (9034) were listed as living with them.¹³

Generation Three

4. Thomas William³ Dyches (1485) (*Charles Dyche*, #8) was born on 12 January 1850 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. Free BMD lists his birthdate as March 1850.²³ He married Sarah Ann Thomas (1486) (see #5), daughter of David Nathan Thomas (1498) and Mary Howells (1499), on 23 May 1872 at Utah Territory.⁶ He died on 28 February 1929 at Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, at age 79.²⁴ He was buried on 1 March 1929 in Wales Cemetery, Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, Section 1.²⁴

He appeared on the 1851 census of Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, in the household of his parents Charles Dyche (1505) and Maria Aston (1506).²⁵ He immigrated on the John DeBoved, arriving 30 April 1863 in New York, New York County, New York.⁶ He appeared on the 1870 Federal census of Wales, Utah Territory, enumerated 4 June 1870. He was a farm laborer.²⁶ He and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486) appeared on the 1880 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah Territory, enumerated 12 June 1880. Their children Margaret Ann (1487), Thomas William (1488) and Roswell Medwin (1492) were listed as living with them.²⁷ He and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486) appeared on the 1900 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 1 June 1900. Their children Thomas William (1488), Roswell Medwin (1492), Charles Thomas (1115), Naomia (1494), Milo Thomas (1495) and Sarah Ann (1496) were listed as living with them. he was a farmer.¹⁰ He and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486) appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 5 January 1920.²⁸

Children of Thomas William³ Dyches (1485) and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486) (see #5) all born at Wales, Utah Territory, were as follows:

- i. Margaret Ann² (1487) was born on 7 June 1875.⁶ She died on 28 February 1885 at Wales, Utah Territory, at age 9.⁶

- iv. Maria (1493) was born on 25 November 1881.⁶ She died on 8 December 1881 at Wales, Utah Territory.⁶

- vi. Naomia (1494) was born on 30 June 1885.⁶ She married Robert Christiansen (14839).³⁰ She died on 10 November 1962 at age 77.⁶
- vii. Milo Thomas (1495) was born on 18 August 1888.³¹ He married Winnifred E. Wasden (9216) on 16 May 1912 at Temple Salt Lake City, Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah.⁶ He died on 8 September 1963 at Murray, Salt Lake County, Utah, at age 75.³² He was buried on 12 September 1963 in Murray City Cemetery, Murray, Salt Lake County, Utah.³³
- viii. Sarah Ann (1496) was born on 18 April 1891.⁶ She died on 21 November 1952 at age 61.⁶
- ix. David T (1497) was born on 1 January 1894.⁶ He died on 13 February 1895 at Wales, Utah Territory, at age 1.⁶

5. Sarah Ann³ Thomas (1486) (*David*, #10) was born on 3 October 1853 at Cwmaman, Aberdare, Glamorgan & Brecon, Wales.⁶ She married Thomas William Dyches (1485) (see #4), son of Charles Dyche (1505) and Maria Aston (1506), on 23 May 1872 at Utah Territory.⁶ She died on 25 February 1935 at Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah, at age 81.⁶ She was buried in Wales, Sanpete County, Utah.⁶

She immigrated on the John S. Boyd, arriving April 1861.⁶ She appeared on the 1870 Federal census of Kanosh, Utah Territory, in the household of her father and step-mother David Nathan Thomas (1498) and Adeline (--?--) (15330).³⁴ She and Thomas William Dyches (1485) appeared on the 1880 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah Territory, enumerated 12 June 1880. Their children Margaret Ann (1487), Thomas William (1488) and Roswell Medwin (1492) were listed as living with them.²⁷ She and Thomas William Dyches (1485) appeared on the 1900 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 1 June 1900. Their children Thomas William (1488), Roswell Medwin (1492), Charles

Thomas (1115), Naomia (1494), Milo Thomas (1495) and Sarah Ann (1496) were listed as living with them. he was a farmer.¹⁰ She and Thomas William Dyches (1485) appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 5 January 1920.²⁸ She appeared on the 1930 Federal census of Salt Lake City, at Salt Lake County, Utah, in the household of her daughter and son-in-law Robert Christiansen (14839) and Naomia Dyches (1494).³⁰

6. Niels Peter³ Nielsen (1484) was born in 1852 at Denmark. His birthdate is calculated from an age of 58 in the 1910 census.²² He married Marian Poulsen (13461) (see #7) in 1873 the marriage date is calculated from Marian's age of 24 at her first marriage listed in the 1930 census.³⁵ He died before 1930. Carol Weggeland Flegge remembers that her grandfather died before she was born in 1930.³⁶

He and Marian Poulsen (13461) immigrated, arriving 1892. Their children Anna Pauline (1124) and Jennie Elvira (1116) traveled with them.²² He and Marian Poulsen (13461) appeared on the 1910 Federal census of Moroni, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 25 April 1910, He was enumerated as Niels P.R. Nielsen.²²

Children of Niels Peter³ Nielsen (1484) and Marian Poulsen (13461) (see #7) were as follows:

- i. Anna Pauline² (1124) was born on 10 June 1878 at Copenhagen, Denmark.¹ She married Frederick Gulbransen (1118), son of Edward Gulbransen (10210) and Elizabeth Syverson (10211), on 6 January 1896 at Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah.¹ She died on 17 August 1961 at Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah, at age 83.¹

7. Marian³ Poulsen (13461) was born in 1849 at Denmark. Her birthdate is calculated from an age of 61 in the 1910 census.³⁷ She married Niels Peter Nielsen (1484) (see #6) in 1873 the marriage date is calculated from Marian's age of 24 at her first marriage listed in the 1930 census.³⁵ She died after 1930 based on photographs that include Marion and her grand-daughter Carol who was born in 1930.³⁶

She and Niels Peter Nielsen (1484) immigrated, arriving 1892. Their children Anna Pauline (1124) and Jennie Elvira (1116) traveled with them.²² She and Niels Peter Nielsen (1484) appeared on the 1910 Federal census of Moroni, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 25 April 1910, He was enumerated as Niels P.R. Nielsen.²² She appeared on the 1930 Federal census of Moroni, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 13 April 1930.³⁸

Generation Four

8. Charles⁴ Dyche (1505) (*William*, #16) was born on 17 February 1811 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ He was baptized on 17 February 1811 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ He married Maria Aston (1506) (see #9), daughter of John Aston (1512) and Sarah Langstone (1513), on 28 July 1833 at St. Mowden's Church, Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ He died circa 1858 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. Free BMD lists one Charles Dyche who died in Burton-on-Trent in December 1855 and another who died in September 1859 and a third in September 1866. One of these is probably this Charles.²³

He was a blacksmith.⁶ He and Maria Aston (1506) appeared on the 1841 census of Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, enumerated 6 June 1841. Their children Harriott (1507), Maria (1508) and Sarah Ann (1509) were listed as living with them.³⁹ He and Maria Aston (1506) appeared on the 1851 census of Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, enumerated 30 March 1851. Their children Harriott (1507), Maria (1508), Sarah Ann (1509), Mary (1511), Elizabeth (1510) and Thomas William (1485) were listed as living with them.²⁵

Children of Charles⁴ Dyche (1505) and Maria Aston (1506) (see #9) all born at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, were as follows:

- i. Harriott³ (1507) was born on 11 July 1834. Her death date has not been found. She died in Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.
- ii. Maria (1508) was born on 25 January 1838. She died on 10 February 1921 at Springville, Utah County, Utah, at age 83. She was buried in Evergreen Cemetery, Springville, Utah County, Utah.
- iii. Sarah Ann (1509) was born circa 1840. She died on 29 April 1861.
- iv. Mary (1511) was born on 2 January 1846. Her death date has not been found.
- v. Elizabeth (1510) was born on 6 April 1846. She died in June 1856 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, at age 10.⁴⁰
4. vi. Thomas William (1485).

9. Maria⁴ Aston (1506) (*John*, #18) was born on 1 January 1812 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ She married Charles Dyche (1505) (see #8), son of William Dyche (1519) and Ann Stokes (1530), on 28 July 1833 at St. Mowden's Church, Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ She died after 1860.⁶

She and Charles Dyche (1505) appeared on the 1841 census of Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, enumerated 6 June 1841. Their children Harriott (1507), Maria (1508) and Sarah Ann (1509) were listed as living with them.³⁹ She and Charles Dyche (1505) appeared on the 1851 census of Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, enumerated 30 March 1851. Their children Harriott (1507), Maria (1508), Sarah Ann (1509), Mary (1511), Elizabeth (1510) and Thomas William (1485) were listed as living with them.²⁵

10. David Nathan⁴ Thomas (1498) (*David*, #20) was born on 22 August 1820 at Carmarthen, Dyfed, South Wales.⁶ He married Mary Howells (1499) (see #11), daughter of David Howells (9215), on 5 November 1842 at Caepantyyll, Merthyr Tydfil, Glamorgan, Wales.⁶ He married Adeline (--?--) (15330) before 1864.³⁴ He died on 14 August 1888 at St. Johns, Apache County, Arizona, at age 67.⁶ He was buried in St. Johns, Apache County, Arizona.⁶

He and Adeline (--?--) (15330) appeared on the 1870 Federal census of Kanosh, Utah Territory, enumerated 2 July 1870. Their children Frances (15331) and David (15332) were listed as living with them. His children Isaac Thomas (1503), Sarah Ann Thomas (1486) and Mary Thomas (1504) were also in the household. He was working as a blacksmith.³⁴

Children of David Nathan⁴ Thomas (1498) and Mary Howells (1499) (see #11) were as follows:

- i. Margaret³ (1502) was born on 7 May 1845 at Ystradgunlais, Brecon, Glamorgan, Wales.⁶ She died on 8 June 1933 at Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, at age 88.⁶ She was buried on 11 June 1933 in Wales, Sanpete County, Utah.⁶
- ii. Isaac (1503) was born on 14 July 1850 at Abadair, Monmouth, Wales.⁶ He died on 12 April 1923 at St. Johns, Apache County, Arizona, at age 72.⁶ He was buried on 14 April 1923 in St. Johns, Apache County, Arizona.⁶
5. iii. Sarah Ann (1486).
- iv. Mary (1504) was born on 1 December 1856 at Cwmaman, Aberdare, Glamorgan & Brecon, Wales.⁶ She died on 28 November 1898 at Pima, Graham County, Arizona, at age 41.⁶

11. Mary⁴ Howells (1499) (*David*, #22) was born circa 1815 at Carmarthen, Dyfed, South Wales.⁶ She married David Nathan Thomas (1498) (see #10), son of David Thomas (1500) and Sarah Nathan (1501), on 5 November 1842 at Caepantyyll, Merthyr Tydfil, Glamorgan, Wales.⁶ She died on 9 October 1858 at Merthyr Tydfil, Glamorgan, Wales. She died while the family was walking towards the ship in which they planned to emigrate to the U.S.⁶

Generation Five

16. William⁵ Dyche (1519) (*William*, #32) was born on 2 July 1780 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ He married Ann Stokes (1530) (see #17) on 13 December 1807 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ He died in December 1850 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, at age 70.²³

He appeared on the (an unknown value) census of Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, enumerated 6 June 1841.³⁹

Children of William⁵ Dyche (1519) and Ann Stokes (1530) (see #17) were as follows:

8. i. Charles⁴ (1505).
- ii. Mary Ann (1531) was born in 1812. She was christened on 20 September 1812 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. Her death date has not been found.
- iii. Ellen (1532) was born in 1812 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. She was christened on 1 November 1812 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. She died in December 1838 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁴⁰
- iv. John (1533) was born in 1814 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. He was christened on 1 January 1815 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. He died before 1822.
- v. Rebecca (1534) was born in 1819 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. She was christened on 29 August 1819 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. Her death date has not been found.

- vi. John (1535) was born in 1822 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. He was christened on 10 February 1822 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. He died in December 1855 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁴⁰

17. Ann⁵ Stokes (1530) was born circa 1786 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ She married William Dyche (1519) (see #16), son of William Dyche (1536) and Ann Saunders (1537), on 13 December 1807 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ She died after 1822.⁶

18. John⁵ Aston (1512) (*William Astle*, #36) was born on 2 June 1773 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ He married Sarah Langstone (1513) (see #19) on 1 March 1798 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ He died before 15 March 1844 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁴¹ He was buried on 15 March 1844 in Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶

He and Sarah Langstone (1513) appeared on the 1841 census of Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, enumerated 6 June 1841. Their son William (1518) was listed as living with them.³⁹

Children of John⁵ Aston (1512) and Sarah Langstone (1513) (see #19) were as follows:

- i. Ann⁴ (1514) was born in 1804. She was christened on 28 October 1804 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. Her death date has not been found.

- v. Hannah (1517) was born in 1819 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. She was christened on 2 May 1819 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. Her death date has not been found.
- vi. William (1518) was born in 1822 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. He was christened on 7 April 1822 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. His death date has not been found.

19. Sarah⁵ Langstone (1513) was born circa 1774 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ She married John Aston (1512) (see #18), son of William Astle (9221) and Hannah (--?--) (9222), on 1 March 1798 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ She died before 15 March 1846 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ She was buried on 15 March 1846 in Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶

She and John Aston (1512) appeared on the 1841 census of Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, enumerated 6 June 1841. Their son William (1518) was listed as living with them.³⁹

20. David⁵ Thomas (1500) was born circa 1781 at Carmarthenshire, South Wales.⁶ He married Sarah Nathan (1501) (see #21) in 1800.⁶ His death date has not been found.

Children of David⁵ Thomas (1500) and Sarah Nathan (1501) (see #21) were:

10. i. David Nathan⁴ (1498).

21. Sarah⁵ Nathan (1501) was born in 1784 at Carmarthenshire, South Wales.⁶ She married David Thomas (1500) (see #20) in 1800.⁶ She died in 1856. FreeBMD lists a number of Sarah Thomases who died in Carmarthen c. 1856 but there is inadequate data to determine if one of these dates belongs to this Sarah.²³

22. David⁵ Howells (9215) was born circa 1789 at Wales.⁶ He died date unknown. Free BMD lists a dozen possible entries that could be the death date of this David Howells beginning in 1840. There is no way to tell which is the correct one from the available data.²³

William⁶ Dyche (1536) (*William Ditch*, #64) was born in 1751 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ He married Ann Saunders (1537) (see #33), daughter of Thomas Saunders (1540) and Rebecca Folloes (1541), on 18 October 1774 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ He died before 14 February 1822 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ He was buried on 14 February 1822 in Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶

Children of William⁶ Dyche (1536) and Ann Saunders (1537) (see #33) were:

Ann⁶ Saunders (1537) (*Thomas*, #66) was born in 1752 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ She was christened on 27 May 1755 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ She married William Dyche (1536) (see #32), son of William Ditch (1538) and Ellen Harrison (1539), on 18 October 1774 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ She died before 27 December 1830 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ She was buried on 27 December 1830 in Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶

36. William⁶ Astle (9221) was born circa 1745 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ He married Hannah (--?--) (9222) (see #37) before 1773 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁶ His death date has not been found. He died in Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.⁴²
