Generation One

1. Richard¹ Green (11979) was born in 1655 at England.¹ His death date has not been found.

Children of Richard¹ Green (11979) include:

2. i. William² (11919) was born circa 1671 at Wiltshire, England. He married Joanna Reeder (11920), daughter of John Reeder (11937) and Joanna Burroughs (11938), before 1696 at Newtown, Province of New York.

Generation Two

2. Judge William² Green (11919) (*Richard¹*) was born circa 1671 at Wiltshire, England.² He immigrated, departing from England, arriving circa 1691 in Philadelphia, Province of Pennsylvania.³ He married Joanna Reeder (11920), daughter of John Reeder (11937) and Joanna Burroughs (11938), before 1696 at Newtown, Province of New York.⁴ He died on 16 June 1722 at Trenton, Province of New Jersey, now Ewing, Mercer County.⁴ He was buried in First Presbyterian Church Cemetery, Ewing, New Jersey, now Mercer County.²

The area where William Green settled was originally called Hopewell Township. It was originally Burlington County, then became part of Hunterdon County in 1713. 125 years later, it was made part of Mercer County. In 1834, Ewing Township was separated from Trenton.³

Joanna Reeder (11920) was born in 1669 at Newtown, Province of New York, now Suffolk County.⁵ She died in 1723.⁶

Children of Judge William² Green (11919) and Joanna Reeder (11920) were as follows:

- i. Richard³ (11921) was born in 1696 at Trenton, Province of West Jersey, now Ewing, Mercer County.² He married Mary Ely, b. c 1710.² He died after 18 June 1741 at Trenton, Province of New Jersey, now Ewing, Mercer County.²
- ii. Joseph (11923) was born in 1698 at Trenton, Province of West Jersey, now Ewing, Mercer County.² He married Elizabeth Mershon (11924) circa 1735 estimated.² He died on 12 March 1784.²

Elizabeth Mershon (11924) was born in 1714.² She died on 12 March 1775.²
- iii. Sarah (11925) was born circa 1701 at Trenton, Province of West Jersey, now Ewing, Mercer County.² She married as her first husband Benjamin Severns (11927) on 28 May 1730 at Province of New Jersey.² She married as her second husband Thomas Smith (11926).² Her death date has not been found.

Benjamin Severns (11927) was born in 1704.² His death date has not been found.
Thomas Smith (11926). Thomas' (11926) birth date is unknown. Thomas (11926) was born in Province of New Jersey, now Hunterdon County.² His death date has not been found.
- iv. Joanna (11922) was born in 1702 at Trenton, Province of West Jersey, now Ewing, Mercer County.² Her death date has not been found.
- v. William (11928) was born in 1702 at Trenton, Province of West Jersey, now Ewing, Mercer County.² He married Lydia Armitage (11929) circa 1732.² He died in February 1785 at Prince Edward County, Virginia.²

Lydia Armitage (11929) was born in 1706 at Trenton, Province of New Jersey, now Mercer County, daughter of Enoch Armitage.² Her death date has not been found.
- vi. Benjamin (11930) was born in 1706 at Trenton, Province of New Jersey, now Ewing, Mercer County.² He married Martha Deen.² His death date has not been found.
- vii. John (11931) was born in 1708 at Trenton, Province of New Jersey, now Ewing, Mercer County.² His death date has not been found.
- viii. Isaac (11932) was born circa 1709 at Trenton, Province of West Jersey, now Ewing, Mercer County.² He married Margaret.² His death date has not been found.
3. ix. Jeremiah (11899) was born on 15 February 1710 at Trenton, Province of West Jersey, now Ewing, Mercer County. He married Joanna Hunt (11900), daughter of John Hunt (11935) and Margaret Moore (11936), in 1738 at Province of New Jersey.
- x. Esther (11933) was born in 1712 at Trenton, Province of New Jersey, now Ewing, Mercer County.² Her death date has not been found.

- xi. Mary (11934) was born in 1714 at Trenton, Province of New Jersey, now Ewing, Mercer County.² Her death date has not been found.

Generation Three

3. Jeremiah³ Green (11899) (*William², Richard¹*) was born on 15 February 1710 at Trenton, Province of West Jersey, now Ewing, Mercer County.² He married Joanna Hunt (11900), daughter of John Hunt (11935) and Margaret Moore (11936), in 1738 at Province of New Jersey.² He died on 12 January 1763 at Jersey Settlement, Yadkin River, Province of North Carolina, at age 52.²

Joanna Hunt (11900) was also known as Hannah (11900).² She was born in 1715 at Province of New Jersey.² She died circa 1789 at Jersey Settlement, Yadkin River, Rowan County, North Carolina.²

Children of Jeremiah³ Green (11899) and Joanna Hunt (11900) were as follows:

- i. Stephen⁴ (11901) was born in 1738 at Province of New Jersey.⁶ His death date has not been found.
- ii. Richard (11902) was born in 1740 at Province of New Jersey.⁷ He married Eleanor Sullivan (11903) circa 1762. They had 10 children.⁸ He died on 27 February 1794 at Blowing Rock, Wilkes County, North Carolina, now Watauga County.⁸

Eleanor Sullivan (11903) was born circa 1740. She was the daughter of Edward. E. Sullivan.² She died before 1817 at Blowing Rock, Ashe County, North Carolina, now Watauga County.²
- iii. Isaac (11904) was born circa 1744 at Province of New Jersey.² He married Margaret (--?--) (11905) circa 1770.² His death date has not been found.

Margaret (--?--) (11905) was born circa 1744.² Her death date has not been found.
- iv. Hannah (11906) was born on 5 May 1746 at Province of New Jersey.⁹ She married Andrew Baird (11907) in 1763. They had four children.⁹ She died on 2 April 1811 at Rowan County, North Carolina, at age 64.⁸

Andrew Baird (11907) was born on 28 January 1737 at Province of New Jersey.¹⁰ He died in 1785 at Rowan County, North Carolina.¹¹ Letters of administration for Andrew's (11907) estate were given to his wife Hannah and Jacob Wiseman on 9 February 1785.¹¹
- v. Mary (11908) was born circa 1747 at Province of New Jersey.⁸ She married John Sloan (11909) on 23 December 1765 at Province of North Carolina. They had four children.⁸ She died circa 1833 at Iredell City, Brunswick County, North Carolina.⁸

John Sloan (11909) was born on 2 August 1740 at Province of Pennsylvania.² He died on 20 June 1780 at Ramsour's Mill, Lincoln County, North Carolina, at age 39.²
- vi. Joanna (11910) was born circa 1752 at Jersey Settlement, Yadkin River, Province of North Carolina.⁶ She died on 17 March 1840 at North Carolina.²
- vii. Sarah (11911) was born circa 1754 at Jersey Settlement, Yadkin River, Province of North Carolina.² She married John Wilson, b. c 1754.² Her death date has not been found.
- viii. Margaret (11912) was born circa 1755 at Province of North Carolina, now Mitchell County.² She married Thomas Burleson, b. c 1755.² Her death date has not been found.
4. ix. Jeremiah (11887) was born on 15 February 1755 at Jersey Settlement, Yadkin River, Province of North Carolina. He married Mary Wiseman (11888), daughter of Jacob Wiseman (11917) and Elizabeth Henderson (11918), on 31 October 1775 at Province of North Carolina. L. Green says 1773.
- x. John (11913) was born on 3 November 1757 at Province of North Carolina.¹² He married Hannah Hunt (11914), daughter of Daniel Hunt (11915) and Susannah Green (11916), on 8 January 1778 at Rowan County, North Carolina.² He died on 21 November 1826 at Rowan County, North Carolina, at age 69.¹³

Hannah Hunt (11914) was born on 8 October 1756 at Province of North Carolina.² Her death date has not been found. She died in North Carolina.²

Generation Four

4. Jeremiah⁴ Green (11887) (*Jeremiah³, William², Richard¹*) was born on 15 February 1755 at Jersey Settlement, Yadkin River, Province of North Carolina.² He married Mary Wiseman (11888), daughter of Jacob Wiseman (11917) and

Elizabeth Henderson (11918), on 31 October 1775 at Province of North Carolina L. Green says 1773.⁸ He died on 30 December 1839 at Three Forks, Ashe County, North Carolina, at age 84.⁸

Mary Wiseman (11888) also went by the nickname Polly (11888). She was born on 16 February 1760 at Province of Pennsylvania.² She died on 15 April 1840 at Silverstone, Ashe County, North Carolina, at age 80.⁶

Children of Jeremiah⁴ Green (11887) and Mary Wiseman (11888) all born at Rowan County, North Carolina, were as follows:

- i. Isaac⁵ (11889) also went by the nickname Flatty (11889).¹³ He was born on 2 July 1776.⁸ He married Mary "Polly" Booth on 21 December 1793 at Rowan County, North Carolina.¹³ He died on 18 February 1855 at Meat Camp, Watauga County, North Carolina, at age 78.⁸
- ii. Enoch (12478) was born circa 1778.¹⁴ He married (1) Elizabeth Booth Sept. 9 1794 and (2) Nancy Toole in 1803 and (3) Lucy Harwood in 1811.¹⁵ He died circa 1848 at Bibb County, Georgia.¹⁴
- iii. Joanna (12479) was born circa 1780.¹⁴ She married Reuben Hartley on 6 November 1798 at Rowan County, North Carolina.¹⁴ Her death date has not been found.
5. iv. Jeremiah (11855) was born on 16 June 1782. He married Katherine Hagaman (11856), daughter of Joseph Hagaman (11898), on 21 October 1804 at Ashe County, North Carolina.
- v. John (11890) was born circa 1784.⁸ He married ? Hagaman, daughter of Joseph and sister of Katherine who married his brother Jeremiah. Her name might have been Sarah.¹⁶ He died in 1869 at Rowan County, North Carolina.¹⁷
- vi. Elizabeth (11893) was born circa 1790.² Her death date has not been found.
- vii. Richard (12480) was born circa 1794.¹⁴ He married Joanna Brown in 1866.¹³ He died in 1869 at Dade County, Missouri.¹⁴
- viii. Jacob (11894) was born on 7 May 1796.⁸ He married Elizabeth Davis in 1815.¹⁸ He appeared on the 1850 Federal census of Watauga, Watauga County, North Carolina, enumerated 11 August 1850, along with his wife and five children.¹⁹ He died on 24 November 1854 at Rowan County, North Carolina, at age 58.⁸
- ix. Nathan (11895) was born in 1800.⁸ He died in 1840 at Rowan County, North Carolina.²⁰
- x. Joseph (12481) was born circa 1804.¹⁴ He died circa 1830 at Rowan County, North Carolina.¹⁴

Generation Five

5. Jeremiah⁵ Green (11855) (*Jeremiah⁴, Jeremiah³, William², Richard¹*) was born on 16 June 1782 at Rowan County, North Carolina.²¹ He married Katherine Hagaman (11856), daughter of Joseph Hagaman (11898), on 21 October 1804 at Ashe County, North Carolina.²² He died on 18 August 1844 at Asheville, Buncombe County, North Carolina, at age 62.²³

Katherine Hagaman (11856) was born on 24 December 1786 at North Carolina.²⁴ She appeared on the 1870 Federal census of Hominy Creek, Buncombe County, North Carolina, in the household of her daughter Samuel Clark (15307) and Temperance Green (11868).²⁵ She died on 14 September 1871 at North Carolina at age 84.²²

Children of Jeremiah⁵ Green (11855) and Katherine Hagaman (11856) were as follows:

- i. Wiseman⁶ (11857) was born on 8 August 1805 at Ashe County, North Carolina.²⁴ He married Mary Glenn (11858) in 1835 at Buncombe County, North Carolina.² He and Mary Glenn (11858) appeared on the 1850 Federal census of Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 2 August 1850.²⁶ He died after 1867 at DeKalb County, Tennessee.²
Mary Glenn (11858) was born in 1796 at North Carolina.² Her death date has not been found.
- ii. Wilson (11859) was born on 5 June 1807 at North Carolina.²⁴ His death date has not been found.
- iii. Susannah (11860) was born on 12 March 1809 at North Carolina.²⁴ She married Daniel Reece (11863) circa 1830 estimated.² Her death date has not been found.
Daniel Reece (11863) was born circa 1809.² His death date has not been found.
- iv. Selinda (13098) was born on 14 February 1811.²⁷ She married Marcus Holsclaw date unknown.²⁷ She appeared on the 1880 Federal census of Ellendale, Alexander County, North Carolina, enumerated 10 June 1880.²⁸ She died before 1882.²⁹
- v. Temperance (11868) was born on 1 October 1812 at North Carolina.²⁴ She married Samuel Clark (15307) before 1847.²⁴ She and Samuel Clark (15307) appeared on the 1870 Federal census of Hominy Creek, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 24 August 1870. Her mother Katherine Hagaman (11856) was living with them.²⁵ Her death date has not been found.

Samuel Clark (15307) was born in 1812 at North Carolina.²⁵ His death date has not been found.

- vi. Wesley (11811) was born on 22 May 1814 at Buncombe County, North Carolina.³⁰ He married as his first wife Susan Morgan (11810), daughter of Jesse Morgan (11802) and Mary Grant (11803), in 1840 at Buncombe County, North Carolina. They had four children.³¹ He married as his second wife Grace Morgan (11812), daughter of Jesse Morgan (11802) and Mary Grant (11803), on 2 June 1850 at Buncombe County, North Carolina. They had five children.³² He and Grace Morgan (11812) appeared on the 1850 Federal census of Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 11 September 1850, along with four children from his first marriage.³³ He and Grace Morgan (11812) appeared on the 1860 Federal census of Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 7 July 1860, along with nine children.³⁴ He and Grace Morgan (11812) appeared on the 1870 Federal census of Hominy Creek, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 2 August 1870, along with four children.³⁵ He appeared on the 1880 Federal census of Upper Hominy Township, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 9 June 1880, along with two of his children.³⁶ He died on 23 April 1885 at Buncombe County, North Carolina, at age 70.³⁷ He was buried in Hominy Baptist Church Cemetery, Buncombe County, North Carolina.³⁷

Susan Morgan (11810) was also known as Susannah (11810).³⁸ She was born on 7 July 1819 at Buncombe County, North Carolina.³¹ She died on 11 October 1849 at Buncombe County, North Carolina, at age 30.³¹

Grace Morgan (11812) was born on 28 May 1820 at Rutherford County, North Carolina.³⁹ She died on 7 August 1878 at Buncombe County, North Carolina, at age 58.⁴⁰ She was buried in Hominy Baptist Church Cemetery, Buncombe County, North Carolina.³⁷

6. vii. William S. (11792) was born on 14 March 1816 at North Carolina. He married Martha Morgan (11793), daughter of Jesse Morgan (11802) and Mary Grant (11803), on 1 December 1837 at Buncombe County, North Carolina.
- viii. Lydia (11872) was born on 13 May 1818.²⁴ She married Adolphus Jones, son of Mangrum and Jenny (Jane) (Sluter) Jones, b. c 1818.²⁴ Her death date has not been found.
- ix. Washington (13099) was born on 5 July 1820.²⁷ His death date has not been found.
- x. Rebecca (11879) was born on 18 June 1822.²² She married William Clark, b. c 1822.²⁴ Her death date has not been found.
- xi. Fanny (11880) was born on 7 August 1824.²² She married Israel Wilson, b. c 1824.²⁴ Her death date has not been found.
- xii. Whitehead (11882) was born on 11 September 1826.²² He married Mary Emaline Morgan (12735), daughter of Jesse Morgan (11802) and Ann Justice (12731), after 1850 They had ten children.⁴¹ His death date has not been found.

Mary Emaline Morgan (12735) was born in 1829. It is unclear if she was the first child of Ann Justice Morgan or the last of Mary Grant Morgan.⁴¹ Her death date has not been found.
- xiii. Jane (11883) was born on 11 September 1828.⁴² She married Elijah Morgan (13102), son of James Morgan (11822) and Margaret Grant (11823), on 3 February 1848 at Buncombe County, North Carolina.³⁷ She and Elijah Morgan (13102) appeared on the 1860 Federal census of Hominy Creek, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 25 July 1860, along with six children.⁴³ She and Elijah Morgan (13102) appeared on the 1870 Federal census of Hominy Creek, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 3 August 1870, along with eight children.⁴⁴ She appeared on the 1880 Federal census of Upper Hominy Township, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 9 June 1880, along with seven children.⁴⁵ She died on 18 January 1890 at Buncombe County, North Carolina, at age 61.³⁷ She was buried in Hominy Baptist Church Cemetery, Buncombe County, North Carolina.³⁷

Elijah Morgan (13102) was born on 9 August 1824 at Buncombe County, North Carolina.³⁷ He died on 27 October 1879 at Buncombe County, North Carolina, at age 55.³⁷ He was buried in Hominy Baptist Church Cemetery, Buncombe County, North Carolina.³⁷
- xiv. Jeremiah (13100) was born on 11 November 1830.²⁷ He married Caroline Morgan (13101) on 26 September 1857.²² His death date has not been found.

Caroline Morgan (13101) was born between 1836 and 1837 at Buncombe County, North Carolina.¹³ Her death date has not been found.
- xv. Katherine (11885) was born on 28 May 1833.²² She died on 18 January 1834.²²

Generation Six

6. William S.⁶ Green (11792) (*Jeremiah⁵, Jeremiah⁴, Jeremiah³, William², Richard¹*) was also known as Williams (11792).⁴⁶ He was born on 14 March 1816 at North Carolina.⁴⁷ He married Martha Morgan (11793), daughter of Jesse Morgan (11802) and Mary Grant (11803), on 1 December 1837 at Buncombe County, North Carolina.⁴¹ He appeared on the census of 1840 at Buncombe County, North Carolina, The household included 2 males 20-29, 1 male under 5, 2 females 20-29 and 1 female under 5.⁴⁸ He was Farmer in 1850.⁴⁹ He and Martha Morgan (11793) appeared on the 1850 Federal census of Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 30 July 1850. Their children Jesse M. (11795), Alfred J. (11797), Thomas L. (11798), Mary J. (11794) and Grace Elizabeth (11796) were listed as living with them.⁴⁹

The 1850 census listed a Jeremiah, age 16 living in William Green's household. He was not present in the 1860 census so his identity is unknown. He might have been a nephew.⁵⁰ He and Martha Morgan (11793) appeared on the 1860 Federal census of Hominy Creek, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 25 July 1860. Their children Mary J. (11794), Jesse M. (11795), Grace Elizabeth (11796), Thomas L. (11798), W. Hilliard (11790), Enoch (11799), Martha M. (11800) and Montraville Buchanan (11801) were listed as living with them.⁵¹ He and Martha Morgan (11793) appeared on the 1870 Federal census of Hominy Creek, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 9 August 1870. Their children Thomas L. (11798), W. Hilliard (11790), Enoch (11799), Martha M. (11800) and Montraville Buchanan (11801) were listed as living with them.⁵² He and Martha Morgan (11793) appeared on the 1880 Federal census of Upper Hominy Township, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 11 June 1880. Their children W. Hilliard (11790), Enoch (11799), Martha M. (11800) and Montraville Buchanan (11801) were listed as living with them.⁵³ He died on 21 January 1888 at Buncombe County, North Carolina, at age 71.⁵⁴ He was buried in Hominy Baptist Church Cemetery, Buncombe County, North Carolina.³⁷

Martha Morgan (11793) also went by the nickname Patsy (11793).⁵⁵ She was born on 7 July 1814 at Rutherford County, North Carolina.³⁹ She died on 13 January 1899 at Buncombe County, North Carolina, at age 84.³⁹ She was buried in Hominy Baptist Church Cemetery, Buncombe County, North Carolina.³⁷

Children of William S.⁶ Green (11792) and Martha Morgan (11793) all born at Buncombe County, North Carolina, were as follows:

- i. Mary J.⁷ (11794) was born on 1 April 1839.³¹ She appeared on the 1850 Federal census of Buncombe County, North Carolina, in the household of her parents William S. Green (11792) and Martha Morgan (11793).⁴⁹ She appeared on the 1860 Federal census of Hominy Creek, Buncombe County, North Carolina, in the household of her parents William S. Green (11792) and Martha Morgan (11793).⁵¹ She married Pinkney Morgan (12739).⁴¹ She died on 17 December 1898 at age 59.⁵⁶

Pinkney Morgan (12739) was born on 22 August 1846 at Buncombe County, North Carolina. He was the son of Lewis R. and Grace Morgan.⁴⁶ He appeared on the 1850 Federal census of Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 30 July 1850, in the household of his parents Lewis and Grace Morgan.⁵⁷ He appeared on the 1860 Federal census of Hominy Creek, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 23 July 1860, in the household of his parents.⁵⁸ He died on 22 September 1868 at age 22.⁴⁶
- ii. Jesse M. (11795) was born on 24 April 1840.³¹ He appeared on the 1850 Federal census of Buncombe County, North Carolina, in the household of his parents William S. Green (11792) and Martha Morgan (11793).⁴⁹ He appeared on the 1860 Federal census of Hominy Creek, Buncombe County, North Carolina, in the household of his parents William S. Green (11792) and Martha Morgan (11793).⁵¹ He married Laura L. Thrash (12740) on 1 August 1867 at Buncombe County, North Carolina.⁴¹ He and Laura L. Thrash (12740) appeared on the 1870 Federal census of Leicester, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 27 August 1870.⁵⁹ He and Laura L. Thrash (12740) appeared on the 1880 Federal census of Leicester, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 1 June 1880, along with three children.⁶⁰ He died on 29 September 1906 at age 66.⁵⁶

Laura L. Thrash (12740) was born in 1845 at North Carolina.⁶¹ She appeared on the 1850 Federal census of Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 30 July 1850, in the household of her parents John and Augusta Thrash.⁶² She appeared on the 1860 Federal census of Hominy Creek, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 16 July 1860, in the household of her parents.⁶³ She appeared on the 1910 Federal census of Asheville, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 15 April 1910, along with several children.⁶⁴ She appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Asheville, Buncombe County, North Carolina, enumerated 14 January 1920.⁶⁵ She died in 1928.⁴⁶

- iii. Grace Elizabeth (11796) was born on 7 May 1842.³¹ She appeared on the 1850 Federal census of Buncombe County, North Carolina, in the household of her parents William S. Green (11792) and Martha Morgan (11793). She was enumerated as Brazilla G.⁴⁹ She appeared on the 1860 Federal census of Hominy Creek, Buncombe County, North Carolina, in the household of her parents William S. Green (11792) and Martha Morgan (11793).⁵¹ She married Isaac Allison on 11 August 1867.³¹ Her death date has not been found.
- iv. Alfred J. (11797) was also known as Alford (11797).³⁸ He was born on 7 July 1843.³¹ He appeared on the 1850 Federal census of Buncombe County, North Carolina, in the household of his parents William S. Green (11792) and Martha Morgan (11793).⁴⁹ He died on 21 June 1892 at age 48.⁵⁶
- v. Thomas L. (11798) was born on 14 January 1845.³¹ He appeared on the 1850 Federal census of Buncombe County, North Carolina, in the household of his parents William S. Green (11792) and Martha Morgan (11793).⁴⁹ He appeared on the 1860 Federal census of Hominy Creek, Buncombe County, North Carolina, in the household of his parents William S. Green (11792) and Martha Morgan (11793).⁵¹ He appeared on the 1870 Federal census of Hominy Creek, Buncombe County, North Carolina, in the household of his parents William S.
