- v. Rebecca (1534) was born in 1819 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. She was christened on 29 August 1819 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. Her death date has not been found.
- vi. John (1535) was born in 1822 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. He was christened on 10 February 1822 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. He appeared on the (an unknown value) census of Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, enumerated 30 March 1851.<sup>5</sup> He died in December 1855 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.<sup>4</sup>

## Generation Four

4. Charles<sup>4</sup> Dyche (1505) (*William<sup>3</sup>, William<sup>2</sup>, William<sup>1</sup> Ditch*) was born on 17 February 1811 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.<sup>1</sup> He was baptized on 17 February 1811 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.<sup>1</sup> He married Maria Aston (1506), daughter of John Aston (1512) and Sarah Langstone (1513), on 28 July 1833 at St. Mowden's Church, Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.<sup>1</sup> He was a blacksmith.<sup>1</sup> He and Maria Aston (1506) appeared on the 1841 census of Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, enumerated 6 June 1841. Their children Harriott (1507), Maria (1508) and Sarah Ann (1509) were listed as living with them.<sup>2</sup> He and Maria Aston (1506) appeared on the 1851 census of Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, enumerated 30 March 1851. Their children Harriott (1507), Maria (1508), Sarah Ann (1509), Mary (1511), Elizabeth (1510) and Thomas William (1485) were listed as living with them.<sup>6</sup> He died circa 1858 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. Free BMD lists one Charles Dyche who died in Burton-on-Trent in December 1855 and another who died in September 1859 and a third in September 1866. One of these is probably this Charles.<sup>3</sup>

Maria Aston (1506) was born on 1 January 1812 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England.<sup>1</sup> She died after 1860.<sup>1</sup>

- iv. Mary (1511) was born on 2 January 1846. She appeared on the 1851 census of Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, in the household of her parents Charles Dyche (1505) and Maria Aston (1506).<sup>6</sup> Her death date has not been found.
- v. Elizabeth (1510) was born on 6 April 1846. She appeared on the 1851 census of Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, in the household of her parents Charles Dyche (1505) and Maria Aston (1506).<sup>6</sup> She died in June 1856 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, at age 10.<sup>4</sup>
5. vi. Thomas William (1485) was born on 12 January 1850. Free BMD lists his birthdate as March 1850. He married Sarah Ann Thomas (1486), daughter of David Nathan Thomas (1498) and Mary Howells (1499), on 23 May 1872 at Utah Territory.

5. Thomas William<sup>5</sup> Dyches (1485) (*Charles<sup>4</sup> Dyche, William<sup>3</sup>, William<sup>2</sup>, William<sup>1</sup> Ditch*) was born on 12 January 1850 at Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England. Free BMD lists his birthdate as March 1850.<sup>3</sup> He appeared on the 1851 census of Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire, England, in the household of his parents Charles Dyche (1505) and Maria Aston (1506).<sup>6</sup> He immigrated on the John DeBoved, arriving 30 April 1863 in New York, New York County, New York.<sup>1</sup> He appeared on the 1870 Federal census of Wales, Utah Territory, enumerated 4 June 1870. He was a farm laborer.<sup>7</sup> He married Sarah Ann Thomas (1486), daughter of David Nathan Thomas (1498) and Mary Howells (1499), on 23 May 1872 at Utah Territory.<sup>1</sup> He and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486) appeared on the 1880 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah Territory, enumerated 12 June 1880. Their children Margaret Ann (1487), Thomas William (1488) and Roswell Medwin (1492) were listed as living with them.<sup>8</sup> He and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486) appeared on the 1900 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 1 June 1900. Their children Thomas William (1488), Roswell Medwin (1492), Charles Thomas (1115), Naomia (1494), Milo Thomas (1495) and Sarah Ann (1496) were listed as living with them. he was a farmer.<sup>9</sup> He and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486) appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete

County, Utah, enumerated 5 January 1920.<sup>10</sup> He died on 28 February 1929 at Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, at age 79.<sup>11</sup> He was buried on 1 March 1929 in Wales Cemetery, Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, Section 1.<sup>11</sup>

Sarah Ann Thomas (1486) was born on 3 October 1853 at Cwmaman, Aberdare, Glamorgan & Brecon, Wales.<sup>1</sup> She immigrated on the John S. Boyd, arriving April 1861.<sup>1</sup> She appeared on the 1870 Federal census of Kanosh, Utah Territory, in the household of her father and step-mother David Nathan Thomas (1498) and Adeline (--?--) (15330).<sup>12</sup> She appeared on the 1930 Federal census of Salt Lake City, at Salt Lake County, Utah, in the household of her daughter and son-in-law Robert Christiansen (14839) and Naomia Dyches (1494).<sup>13</sup> She died on 25 February 1935 at Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah, at age 81.<sup>1</sup> She was buried in Wales, Sanpete County, Utah.<sup>1</sup>

Children of Thomas William<sup>5</sup> Dyches (1485) and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486) all born at Wales, Utah Territory, were as follows:

- i. Margaret Ann<sup>6</sup> (1487) was born on 7 June 1875.<sup>1</sup> She appeared on the 1880 Federal census of Wales, Utah Territory in the household of her parents Thomas William Dyches (1485) and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486).<sup>8</sup> She died on 28 February 1885 at Wales, Utah Territory, at age 9.<sup>1</sup>
- ii. Thomas William (1488) was born on 23 September 1877.<sup>14</sup> He appeared on the 1880 Federal census of Wales, Utah Territory in the household of his parents Thomas William Dyches (1485) and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486).<sup>8</sup> He appeared on the 1900 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of his parents Thomas William Dyches (1485) and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486).<sup>9</sup> He appeared on the 1910 Federal census of Castle Dale, Emery County, Utah, enumerated 5 May 1910, The household included his wife Ada and son Ronald.<sup>15</sup> He registered for the draft for World War I on 12 September 1918, while living at Manti, Sanpete County, Utah, reporting he was employed as farmer and school teacher.<sup>16</sup> He appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Mount Pleasant, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 22 January 1920, along with his wife Ada.<sup>17</sup> He died on 16 July 1955 at age 77.<sup>1</sup>
- iii. Roswell Medwin (1492) was born on 30 November 1879.<sup>14</sup> He appeared on the 1880 Federal census of Wales, Utah Territory in the household of his parents Thomas William Dyches (1485) and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486).<sup>8</sup> He appeared on the 1900 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of his parents Thomas William Dyches (1485) and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486).<sup>9</sup> He appeared on the 1910 Federal census of Moroni, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 22 April 1910, The household included his wife Annie and sons Melvin and Joseph.<sup>18</sup> He registered for the draft for World War I on 12 September 1918, while living at Manti, Sanpete County, Utah, reporting he was employed as barber.<sup>16</sup> He appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Moroni, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 27 January 1920, along with his wife and six children. His occupation was listed as "barber."<sup>19</sup> He died on 19 May 1954 at Moroni, Sanpete County, Utah, at age 74.<sup>1</sup> He was buried in Moroni, Sanpete County, Utah.<sup>1</sup>
- iv. Maria (1493) was born on 25 November 1881.<sup>1</sup> She died on 8 December 1881 at Wales, Utah Territory.<sup>1</sup>
6. v. Charles Thomas (1115) was born on 30 April 1883. He married as his first wife Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116), daughter of Niels Peter Nielsen (1484) and Marian Poulsen (13461), on 31 May 1905 at Manti, Sanpete County, Utah. He married as his second wife Macel Beal (1117) on 22 December 1927 at Manti, Sanpete County, Utah.
- vi. Naomia (1494) was born on 30 June 1885.<sup>1</sup> She appeared on the 1900 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of her parents Thomas William Dyches (1485) and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486).<sup>9</sup> She married Robert Christiansen (14839).<sup>13</sup> She and Robert Christiansen (14839) appeared on the 1930 Federal census of Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah, enumerated 3 April 1930. Her mother, Sarah Ann Thomas (1486) was living with them.<sup>13</sup> She died on 10 November 1962 at age 77.<sup>1</sup>

Robert Christiansen (14839) was born circa 1886 at Utah Territory. His age is calculated from an age of 44 in the 1930 census.<sup>13</sup> His death date has not been found.
7. vii. Milo Thomas (1495) was born on 18 August 1888. He married Winnifred E. Wasden (9216) on 16 May 1912 at Temple Salt Lake City, Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah.
- viii. Sarah Ann (1496) was born on 18 April 1891.<sup>1</sup> She appeared on the 1900 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of her parents Thomas William Dyches (1485) and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486).<sup>9</sup> She died on 21 November 1952 at age 61.<sup>1</sup>
- ix. David T (1497) was born on 1 January 1894.<sup>1</sup> He died on 13 February 1895 at Wales, Utah Territory, at age 1.<sup>1</sup>

## Generation Six

6. Charles Thomas<sup>6</sup> Dyches (1115) (*Thomas<sup>5</sup>, Charles<sup>4</sup> Dyche, William<sup>3</sup>, William<sup>2</sup>, William<sup>1</sup> Ditch*) was born on 30 April 1883 at Wales, Utah Territory.<sup>20</sup> He appeared on the 1900 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of his parents Thomas William Dyches (1485) and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486).<sup>9</sup> He married as his first wife Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116), daughter of Niels Peter Nielsen (1484) and Marian Poulsen (13461), on 31 May 1905 at Manti, Sanpete County, Utah.<sup>1</sup> He and Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116) appeared on the 1910 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 19 April 1910. Their children William (9029), Charles Valdin (9030) and Jennie Elvira (9031) were listed as living with them.<sup>21</sup> He registered for the draft for World War I on 12 September 1918, while living at Manti, Sanpete County, Utah, reporting he was employed as farmer.<sup>16</sup> He and Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116) appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 7 January 1920. Their children William (9029), Charles Valdin (9030), Jennie Elvira (9031), Floyd (9032), Doyle Neilsen (9033) and Verda (9034) were listed as living with them.<sup>22</sup> He married as his second wife Macel Beal (1117) on 22 December 1927 at Manti, Sanpete County, Utah.<sup>23</sup> He and Macel Beal (1117) appeared on the 1930 Federal census of Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, enumerated 10 April 1930. His children Floyd (9032), Doyle Neilsen (9033) and Verda (9034) were listed as living with them. Her children Ariala Howard (13928) and Arden Howard (13929) were also in the household.<sup>24</sup> He died on 17 December 1964 at Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, at age 81.<sup>25</sup> He was buried in Wales Cemetery, Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, Section 4.<sup>26</sup>

Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116) was born on 13 December 1886 at Arhus, Arhus, Denmark.<sup>27</sup> She immigrated, arriving 1892 with her parents Niels Peter Nielsen (1484) and Marian Poulsen (13461).<sup>28</sup> She died on 16 April 1925 at Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, at age 38. Her cause of death was Chronic Parenchymatous Nephritis.<sup>29</sup> She was buried on 19 April 1925 in Wales Cemetery, Wales, Sanpete County, Utah, Section 4.<sup>30</sup>

Children of Charles Thomas<sup>6</sup> Dyches (1115) and Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116) were as follows:

- i. William<sup>7</sup> (9029) was born on 14 November 1905.<sup>31</sup> He appeared on the 1910 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of his parents Charles Thomas Dyches (1115) and Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116).<sup>21</sup> He appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of his parents Charles Thomas Dyches (1115) and Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116).<sup>22</sup> He died in November 1982 at Utah. His last residence was Salt Lake City.<sup>32</sup>
- ii. Charles Valdin (9030) was born on 15 December 1907.<sup>31</sup> He appeared on the 1910 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of his parents Charles Thomas Dyches (1115) and Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116).<sup>21</sup> He appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of his parents Charles Thomas Dyches (1115) and Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116).<sup>22</sup> He died in May 1969 at Utah at age 61. His last residence was Clawson, Emery County, UT.<sup>32</sup>
- iii. Jennie Elvira (9031) is still living.
- iv. Floyd (9032) was born on 22 November 1911.<sup>31</sup> He appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of his parents Charles Thomas Dyches (1115) and Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116).<sup>22</sup> He appeared on the 1930 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of his father and step-mother Charles Thomas Dyches (1115) and Macel Beal (1117).<sup>24</sup> He died in August 1982 at Utah at age 70. His last residence was Salt Lake City.<sup>32</sup>
- v. Doyle Neilsen (9033) was born on 17 November 1913.<sup>31</sup> He appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of his parents Charles Thomas Dyches (1115) and Jennie Elvira Nielsen (1116).<sup>22</sup> He appeared on the 1930 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of his father and setp-mother Charles Thomas Dyches (1115) and Macel Beal (1117).<sup>24</sup> He died on 23 June 1967 at Utah at age 53. His last residence was Mount Pleasant, Sanpete County, UT.<sup>33</sup> He was buried in Mount Pleasant City Cemetery, Mount Pleasant, Sanpete County, Utah.<sup>34</sup>
- vi. Verda (9034); First name hard to read is still living.
8. vii. LaMar Dyches (9) was born on 10 March 1925 at Wales, Sanpete County, Utah. He married as his first wife Mary Ann Green (10), daughter of Willis Wilson Green (1119) and Ida Blanche Gardner (1120), on 27 August 1947 at Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah. He and Mary Ann Green (10) were divorced circa 1960. He married as his second wife Jeanne Hull (1108), daughter of Frank Gilbert Hull (4193) and Winifred Gertrude Tuttle (4194), circa 1965.

Macel Beal (1117) was born circa 1894 at Utah Territory. Her birthdate is estimated from an age of 36 in the 1930 census.<sup>24</sup> She married as her first husband Frank Howard (13927) before 1914.<sup>35</sup> She and Frank Howard (13927) appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Emery, Emery County, Utah, enumerated 12 January 1920. Their children Ariala (13928) and Arden (13929) were listed as living with them. The family was also enumerated in Huntington two weeks later.<sup>36</sup> Her death date has not been found.

7. Milo Thomas<sup>6</sup> Dyches (1495) (*Thomas<sup>5</sup>, Charles<sup>4</sup> Dyche, William<sup>3</sup>, William<sup>2</sup>, William<sup>1</sup> Ditch*) was born on 18 August 1888 at Wales, Utah Territory.<sup>37</sup> He appeared on the 1900 Federal census of Wales, Utah in the household of his parents

Thomas William Dyches (1485) and Sarah Ann Thomas (1486).<sup>9</sup> He married Winnifred E. Wasden (9216) on 16 May 1912 at Temple Salt Lake City, Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah.<sup>1</sup> He registered for the draft for World War I on 5 June 1917, while living at Scipio, Millard County, Utah, reporting he was employed as farmer.<sup>16</sup> He was a school teacher and forest ranger.<sup>1</sup> He and Winnifred E. Wasden (9216) appeared on the 1920 Federal census of Scipio, Millard County, Utah, enumerated 29 January 1920. Their children Virginia Wasden (9217), Milo Fredric (9218) and Harold Thomas (9219) were listed as living with them. His occupation was listed as school teacher.<sup>38</sup> He and Winnifred E. Wasden (9216) appeared on the 1930 Federal census of Monroe, Sevier County, Utah, enumerated 19 April 1930. Their children Virginia Wasden (9217), Milo Fredric (9218), Harold Thomas (9219), David Mark (9220) and Winifred (9223) were listed as living with them.<sup>39</sup> He died on 8 September 1963 at Murray, Salt Lake County, Utah, at age 75.<sup>40</sup> He was buried on 12 September 1963 in Murray City Cemetery, Murray, Salt Lake County, Utah.<sup>41</sup>

Winnifred E. Wasden (9216) was born on 18 January 1891 at Scipio, Utah Territory. She was the daughter of Fredric Louis and Anna Maria Christina (Eskelund) Wasden.<sup>42</sup> She appeared on the 1900 Federal census of Scipio, Millard County, Utah, enumerated 7 June 1900, in the household of her parents Fred and Anna Wasden.<sup>43</sup> She appeared on the 1910 Federal census of Scipio, Millard County, Utah, enumerated 15 April 1910, in the household of her parents.<sup>44</sup> She died on 23 July 1973 at Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah, at age 82.<sup>40</sup> She was buried in Murray City Cemetery, Murray, Salt Lake County, Utah.<sup>34</sup>

Children of Milo Thomas<sup>6</sup> Dyches (1495) and Winnifred E. Wasden (9216) were as follows:
